## Notifiable infectious diseases

- Acute encephalitis/meningitis: bacterial
- Acute encephalitis/meningitis: viral
- Meningococcal Septicaemia • Anthrax • Chickenpox

- Gastroenteritis (persons under 2 years of age only)
